As your Queen this past year, I have endeavored to represent Nydia Temple No. 4 in a competent, fun, and overall positive light. I think that it's not only important for our Ladies of the Household, but also to outside entities including Supreme Temple and other Masonic organizations. As such, I also believe our membership needs to know just what on earth their Queen has been up to. Installation:

Sunday March 20, 2022 I was installed as Queen of Nydia Temple No. 4 with a full complement of officers. There was a total of 100 plus people in attendance. This was, I hoped, an encouraging start of the year as we had just entered a period with Covid waning, but there were no guarantees. All we could do was move forward and hope for the best.

Stated and Special Sessions:

Stated and special sessions have been held regularly throughout this year. 4/6/22, first meeting; 5/4/22, Nydia Temple birthday; 6/1/22, special session with balloting followed by the traditional Supreme Session Kickoff Luncheon; 8/28/22, Supreme Queen's Visit, Ceremonial and banquet; 9/7/22, Honored Past Queens; 10/5/22, regular session; 11/2/22, Founders Day; 12/7/22, Holiday Session; 1/4/23, Flannel Formals Session; 2/1/23, Memorial; and 3/1/23, Elections.

Ceremonials and Obligation-Only Ceremonies:

At our Supreme Queen's Visit in 8/27/22 we initiated three new members and also invited the previous Obligation Only Zoom initiates to watch the ritual work performed, receive their jewels, and be involved in the White Rose Christening. Another Ceremonial was performed on 1/15/23 where we initiated five new members. This was followed by the Traditional Queen's Tea. Practices were done a couple days prior to each Ceremonial and were expertly led by our Ceremonial Assistant, PQ Holly Austin.
